By signing this document, you irrevocably, exclusively, unpaid, and unlimited in time, space, and method of exploitation, grant DBSUF the right to use your image as it appears in photos/videos made by the company in connection with the event.

Furthermore, DBSUF wishes to periodically send you information regarding marketing activities, and for this purpose, we need your consent.

NOTICE

Data controller identification: Danube-Black Sea University Foundation (DBSUF), an NGO based in Venus Resort, Mangalia Municipality, Nicolaie Iorga Street, no. 38, Constanta County, Romania. Please read the entire document carefully.

The purpose of this document is to provide information regarding the processing of your personal data in the context of an event, but also in the context of the direct project activity carried out by the organization. The data subjects are event participants, including guests, speakers, and representatives of the organizing company or other entities.

We rely on your consent to process personal data for marketing purposes. We rely on legitimate interest to process personal data for organizing, accrediting, and conducting the event you participate in, to capture the atmosphere and overall impression of the event, evaluate the number of participants, as well as for project purposes, including promoting the activity/image/project or the event publicly or privately, or for other internal/external purposes of DBSUF. Selected recordings/photos may be published, for example, on the internet, on external platforms, social media accounts, or online press (Twitter, Facebook, YouTube, LinkedIn, Instagram, etc.) or within the framework of the BSB831 project partnership, HERiPRENEURSHIP. The personal data processed for these purposes may include: name and surname; address; phone number; email address; signature; employer/represented entity; position/function/quality/personal biography; image; voice; presence; behavior at the Event. The legal basis is/ can be, where applicable, Art. 6(1)(a), (f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR").

Furthermore, for the aforementioned purposes, we may disclose/transfer the necessary part of your personal data, where applicable (including, but not limited to, photographs and recordings from the Event), to certain public institutions/authorities or public/private organizations (e.g., the Ministry of Development in Romania, for the purpose of proving the Event's development), as well as to other individuals or other companies, including partners of the Organization or other third parties who own/manage/mediate physical/online advertising spaces/media or other social networks/platforms.

The period for which your data will be stored varies depending on the purpose for which we use them and the category of data, and our storage policy is based on legal provisions, including accounting, archiving, or prescription rules.
